**Descriptions:**

**Dialup** -- Dialup is available anywhere, but a phone is required. The slowest internet available. Probably the easiest to switch to, you will just need to modify your USU dialup settings.

**High Speed Internet** -- faster downloading, quicker web surfing. Always on connectivity, no dialing up. Will need a network switch or router to share with 2 or more computers.\*\* Below options are high speed \*\*

**Wireless** -- A high speed internet solution available for most of cache county. Reliability isn't as good as dsl or cable, but speeds are comparable. Usually have data transfer limits. Will have an antenna mounted on your house. Prices are fairly competitive.

**DSL** -- Must upgrade to or get a DSL line from your phone company. Only available in certain areas (check [qwest.com/dsl](http://qwest.com/dsl)) Will need a DSL modem (available to rent or buy), and line conditioners for existing phones. You can pick a separate ISP. Prices quoted are for 256Kbps (unless otherwise noted), faster speeds available for additional charge. 256Kbps is sufficient for web browsing, you may want to get a faster line if you download a lot.

**Cable** -- Regarded as the faster internet, but pricey. Need to rent a cable modem for \$3 a month or buy. Can get basic cable for \$10 extra. See [comcast.com](http://comcast.com) for available in your area. Price quoted is for 4Mbps, faster speeds available for additional charge.

**Satellite** -- Satellite is available anywhere with a clear view of the south sky. Very restrictive if you download too much. Very pricy
