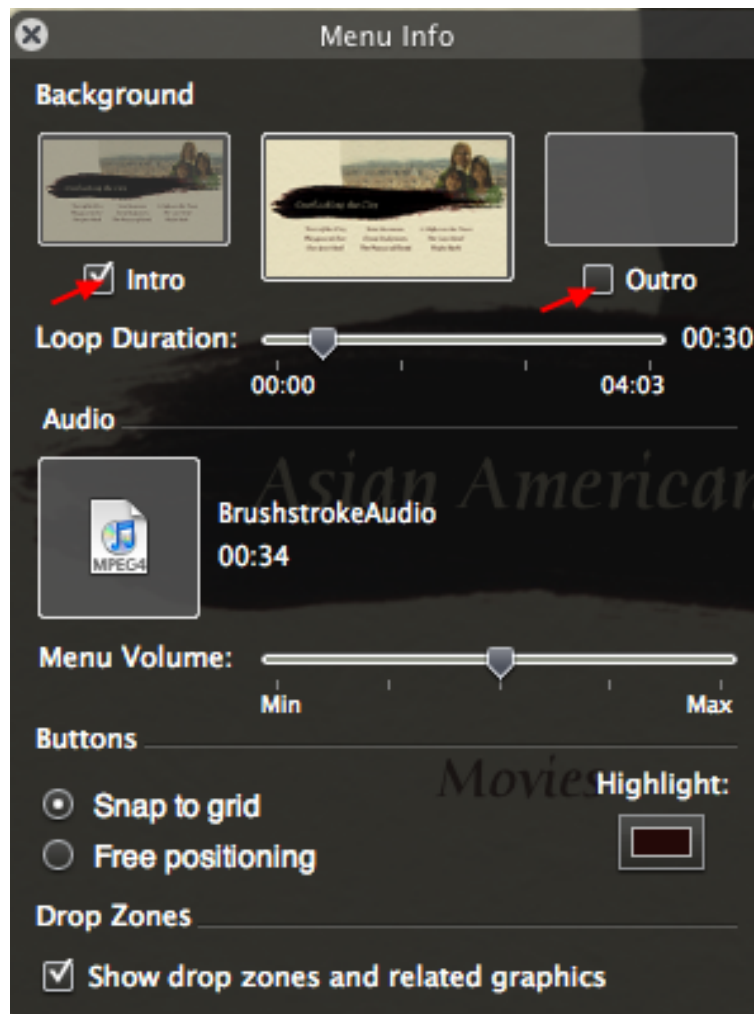

Click on "Show inspector window"

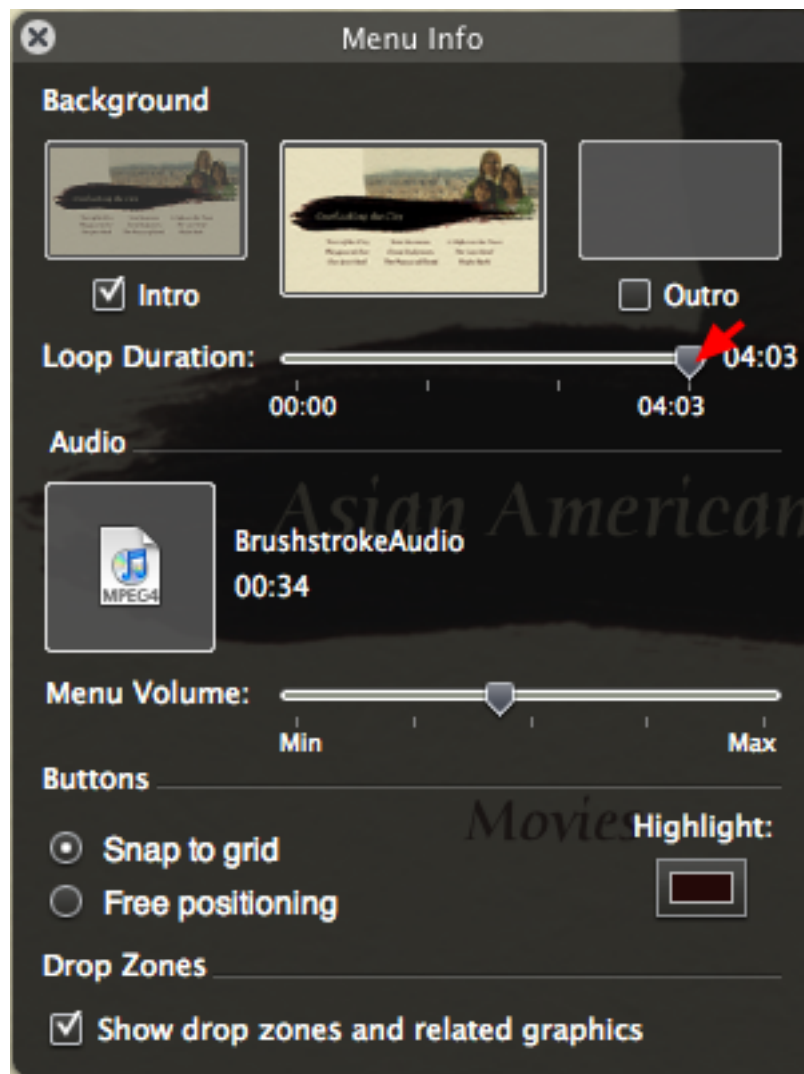


Change the "Intro" and "Outro"



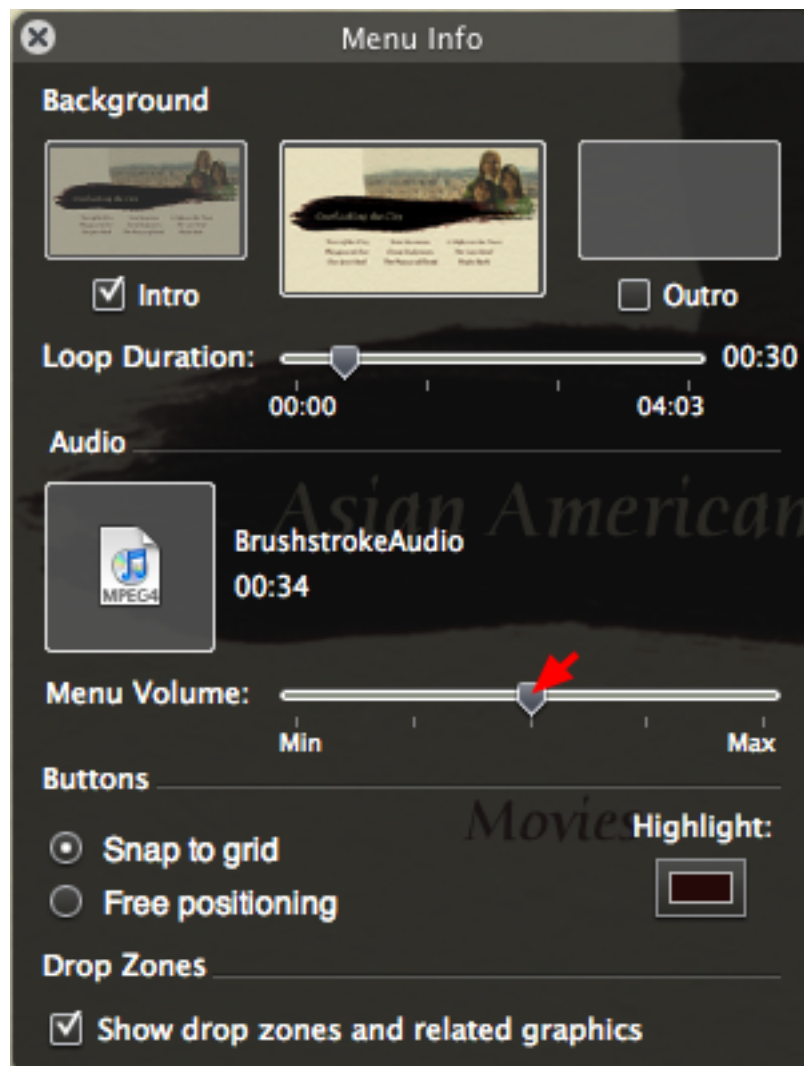
- Check the box if you want to apply changes to the intro.
- Uncheck the box if you don't want the intro.
  - \* The intro is the effects that happen before the main menu appears.
  - \* Some themes do not have an "Outro", so you will not be able to check the outro box.

## Change the "Loop Duration"



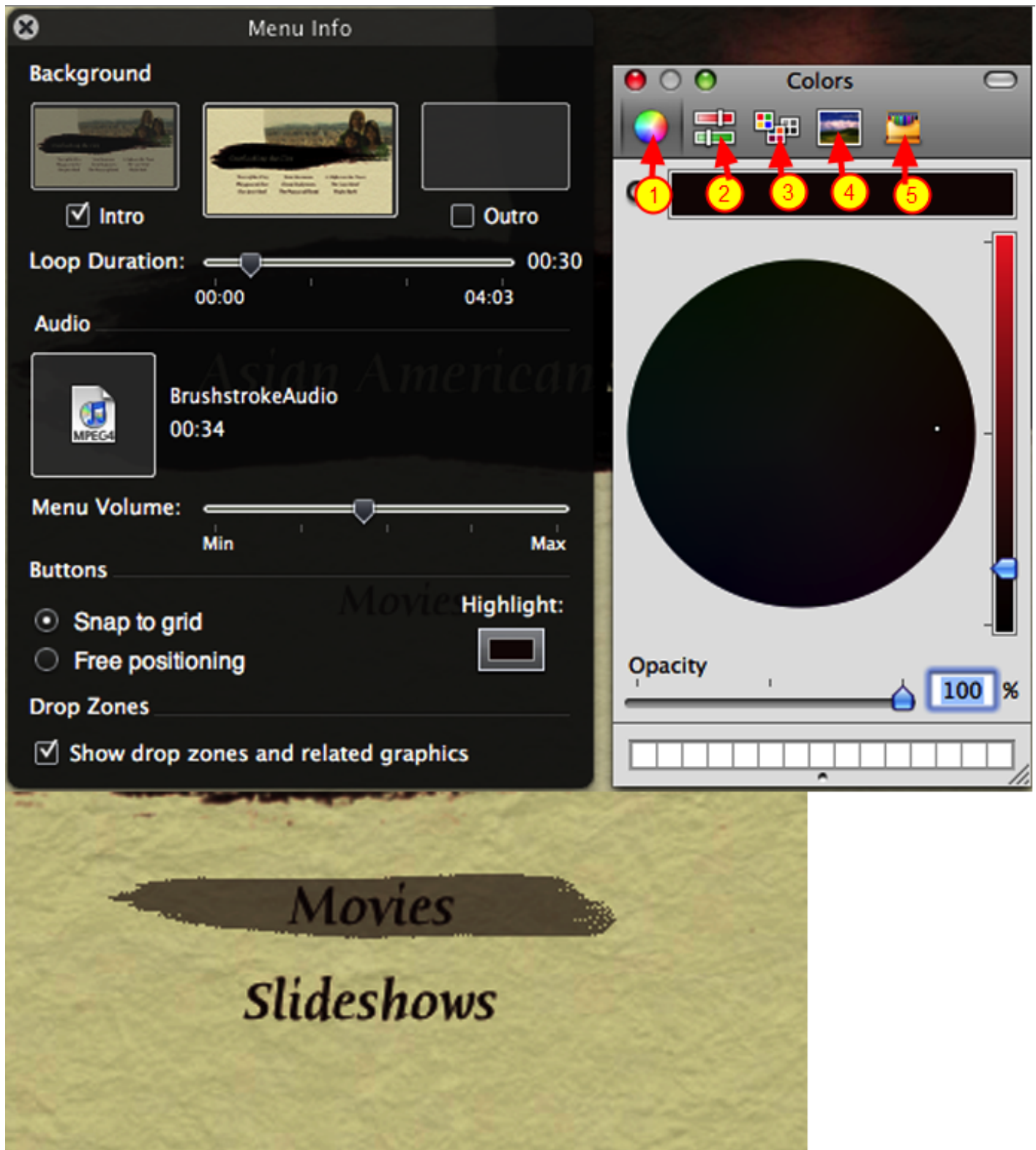
- "Loop Duration" is the amount of time the main menu will play until it replays again.
- To change the loop duration, move the slider either left (less amount of time) or right (more amount of time).

## Change the "Menu Volume"



You can change the menu volume by clicking and dragging the slider either left (softer) or right (louder).

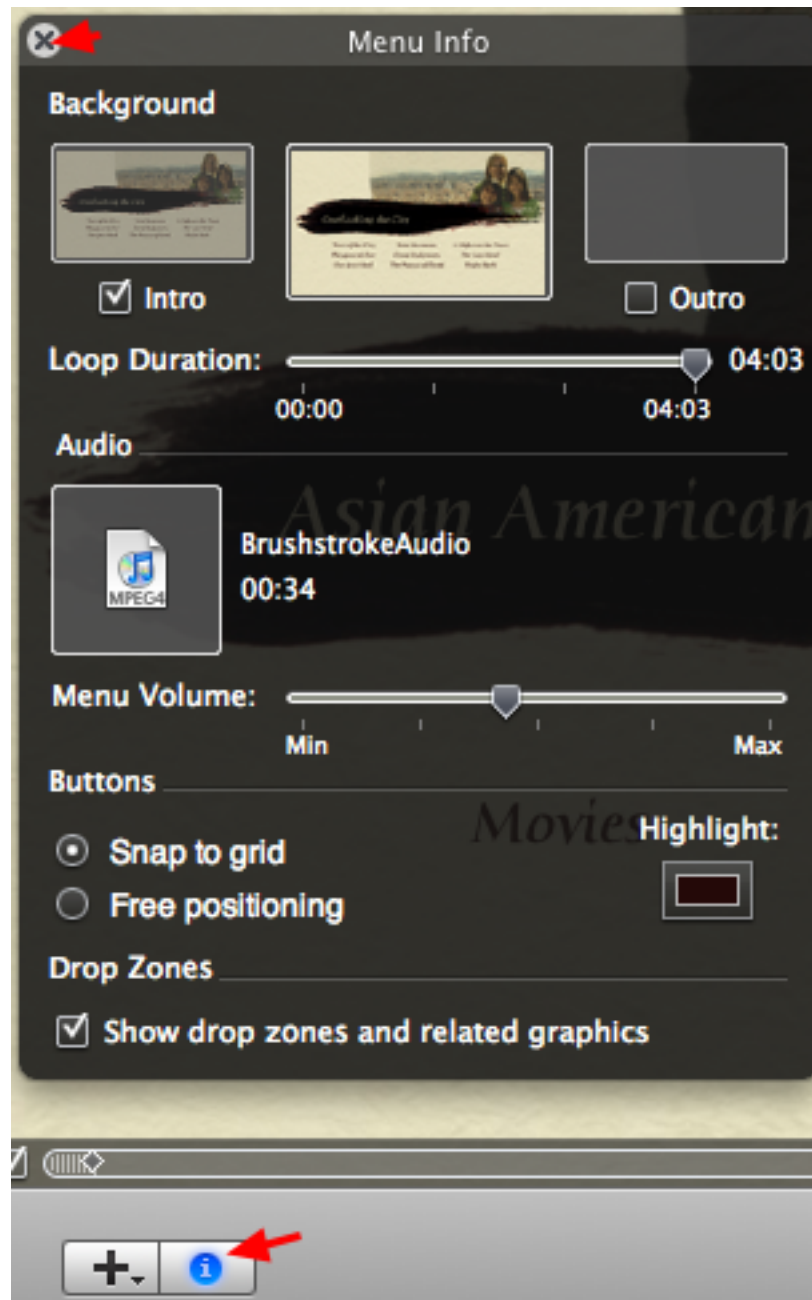
## Change the "Highlight"



- "Highlight" is what highlights the submenu to indicate what is being selected.
- Click on the "Highlight" box to change the color of the highlight.
- Different ways of selecting a color
  - 1 - Color wheel

- 2 - Color sliders
  - 3 - Color palette
  - 4 - Image palette
  - 5 - Crayons
- Once you have selected a color exit the colors box by clicking on the red circle at the top left corner.

## Exit



To exit the "Menu Info," click on the " x " icon at the top left corner or click on "Hide Inspector Window"
