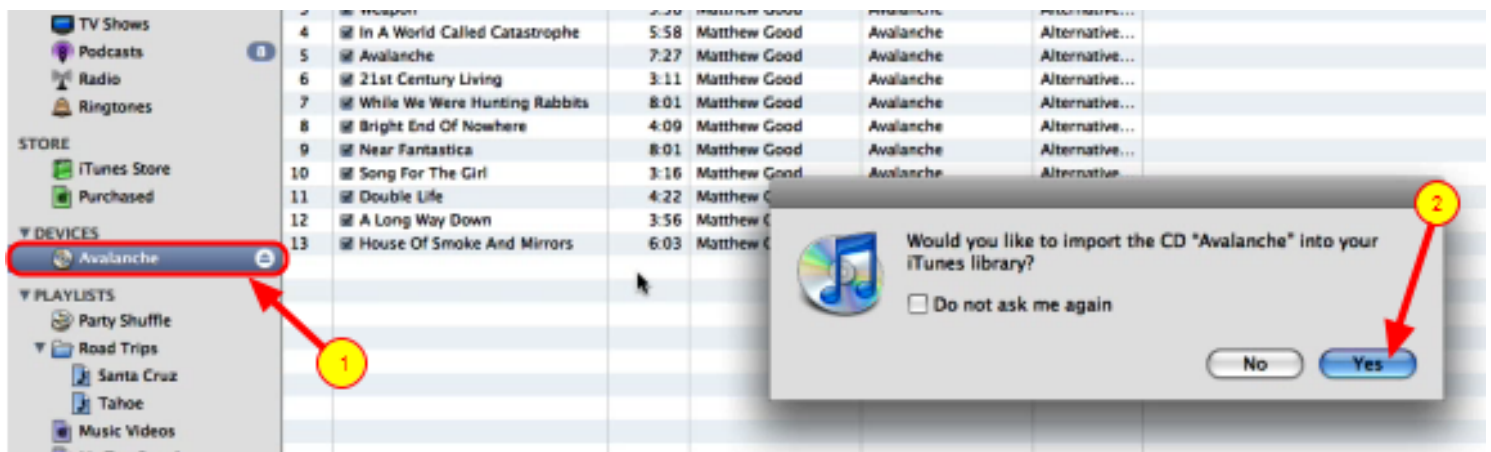

Start Importing



When you insert a CD, iTunes may or may not open automatically. If it doesn't, then open it.

- 1) When your CD has been inserted, it will show up under the "**Devices**" menu.
- 2) Next, you will be asked if you would like to import the CD. Click "**Yes**".

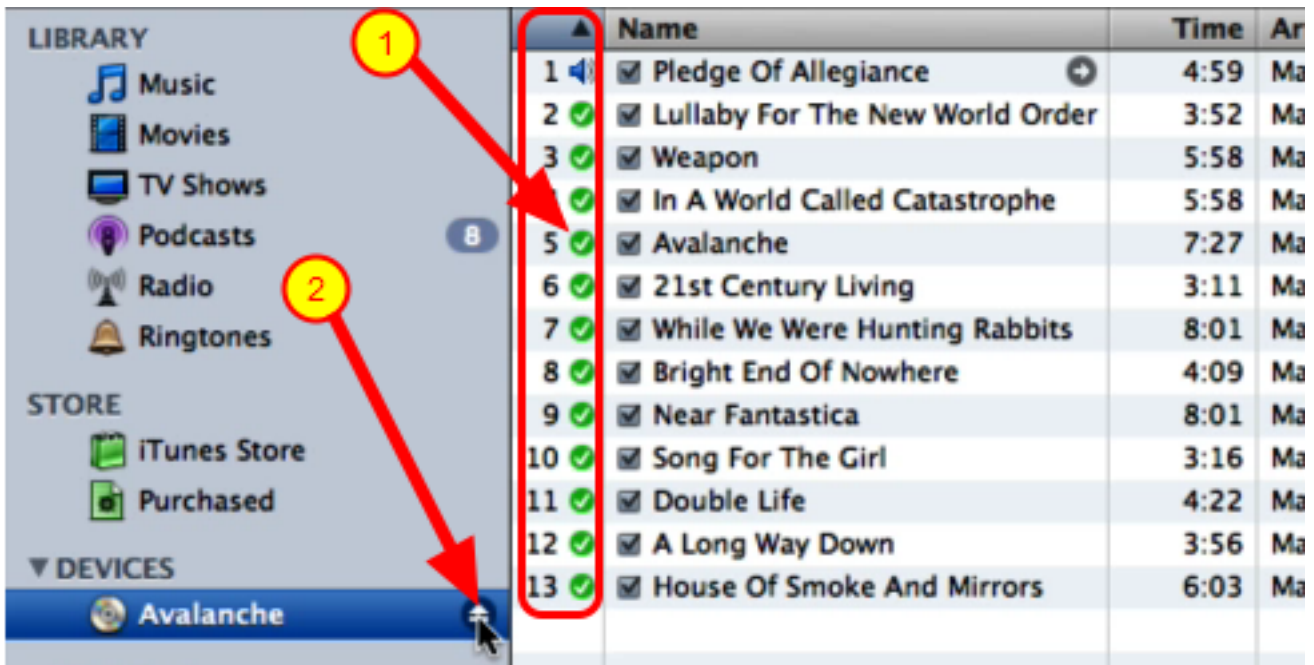
During Importing



iTunes gets right to work, converting your music to digital files.

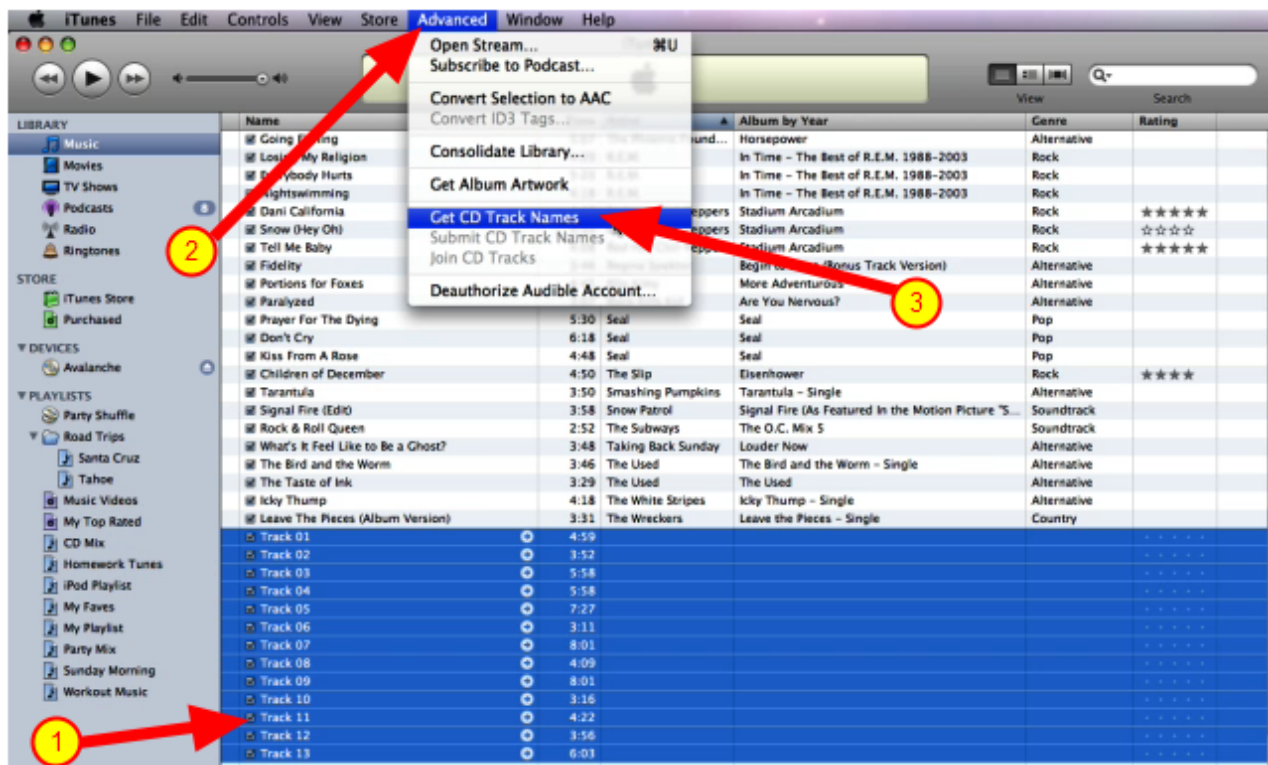
- 1) The orange dot show which song it is importing.
- 2) The progress is shown in the window above.

Finish Importing



- 1) When iTunes is finished importing a song, a green check mark will appear next to the track.
- 2) When iTunes is finished importing all the songs, click the "**eject**" button to eject your CD.

Retrieve Song Names From The Internet



If you don't see song names when you insert a CD iTunes can get them for you the next time you connect to the Internet.

- 1) Just select the songs.

- 2) Then, open the "**Advanced**" menu.
- 3) And choose "**Get CD Track Names**".

NOTE: You don't need to reinsert the original CD into your computer, iTunes automatically adds all the information for the selected songs.
