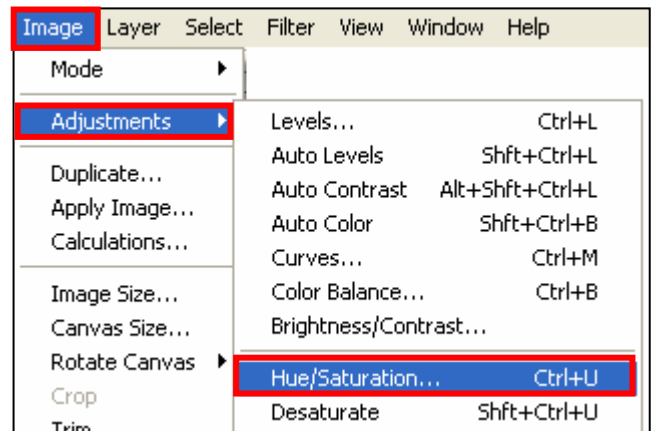


# TIPS TRICKS<sup>AND</sup> HOW TO...

## Adjust the Hue, Saturation, and Lightness of an image using Adobe Photoshop 7.0

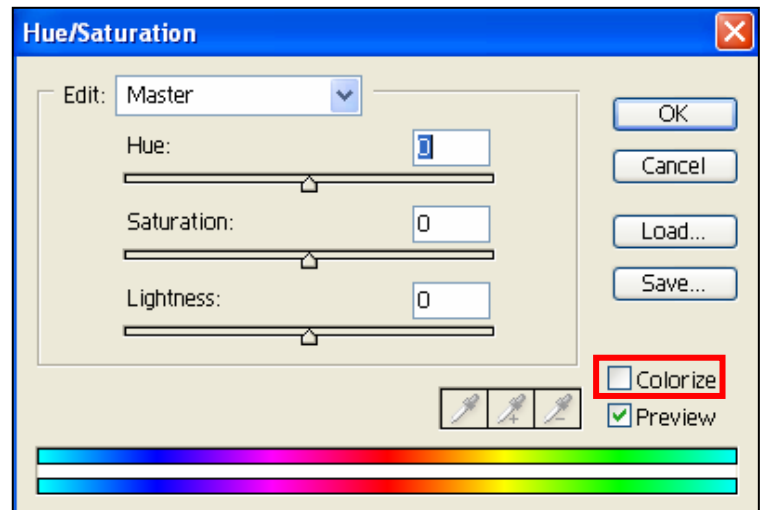
Select “Image” from the menu bar then select “Adjustments” and “Hue/Saturation.”

The Hue/Saturation dialogue box will appear.



### Hue

Adjusting the Hue will change the colors in your photograph. Watch as you adjust the hue bar how the rainbow bars at the bottom of the box change. By clicking the “Colorize” checkbox, your picture becomes one color and allows you to make your entire photograph varying shades of one color.



### Saturation

Adjusting the Saturation allows you to intensify or bring down the colors in your photograph. (You can totally desaturate your photograph by bringing this option all the way to the left, making your image black and white.)

### Lightness

Adjusting the lightness can make a really dark photograph lighter shades or vice versa. You can preview your adjustments by watching your picture in the workspace.

*Note: Nothing is permanent until you click “OK.”*
